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### 1. Introduction

The Korean Language School(KLS) is one of the Soonchunhyang University(SCH)'s Korean Language Institute. The SCH KLS curriculum helps not only International Language School students, but also foreigners residing in Korea who want to learn Korean language and culture.

The Korean language courses are divided into 10-week and 5-week programs. The 10-week program is designed for foreign students with the goal of enrolling in domestic universities and focuses on comprehensive Korean language learning. The 5-week program, on the other hand, emphasizes practical Korean language skills required for daily life.

The SCH KLS provides the following special benefits to the KLS students.

### 5. Admission Requirements

▶ Legal residents with the ability to pursue language courses at domestic universities

\* No nationality or age restrictions apply

### 6. Admission Process

#### A 10-week Program

#### Admission Eligibility Verification

Admission applications are accepted only from those who meet the eligibility criteria \* Prior inquiry is necessary to determine eligibility for admission

#### **Check Admission Guidelines**

It is essential to thoroughly understand the admission guidelines before submitting your application \* Any disadvantages resulting from a lack of understanding are the responsibility of the applicant

#### Submit Application and Documents

Submit the admission application and required documents within the designated period for each semester \* Failure to adhere to the specified deadline will result in the inability to process your admission application

#### Admission Documents Screening

Admission eligibility, study plan, document completeness, and other factors are qualitatively evaluated based on the admission application and required documents

  - Adjustments to courses as needed based on request

#### ★ Important Note for Required Documents ★=

- A. All admission documents(excluding some documents such as Alien Registration Cards and passports) must be submitted in Korean or English
- B. Admission documents may vary depending on the applicant's conditions
- C. It is mandatory to submit documents within the specified deadline, and late submissions will not be accepted
- D. If any discrepancy or error is found in the document review process, it will not be accepted
- E. Submitted documents will not be returned

### 8. Important Notes

- A. Personal information(such as English name, date of birth, etc.) on the Admission Application Form(or Course Registration Form) must match the information on the passport or Alien Registration Card. Any disadvantages due to inaccuracies in the application form are the applicant's responsibility. Also, changes to the information after submission are not allowed
- B. Submitted documents will not be returned
- C. Falsification, forgery, or omission of key information in eligibility and admission documents, leading to successful admission, will result in the cancellation of admission
- D. Adherence to the specified schedule(document submission, tuition payment, etc.) is mandatory
  - \* Failure to submit admission documents within the designated period will result in the inability to apply for admission
  - \* If accepted students do not pay tuition within the specified deadline, their enrollment will be forfeited without further notice
- E. Admission Committee may decide not to admit individuals who are considered incapable of studying at the university's Korean Language School regardless of the number of available slots
- F. Acceptance status is communicated through E-MAIL or by phone
- G. Admission documents must be submitted as specified in the admission guidelines. Failure to comply will result in non-acceptance. If additional documents are required by the university, they must be submitted within the given deadline
  - \* Admission documents may vary depending on the applicant's conditions
- H. If there are any special health conditions(such as highly contagious diseases), admission(permission to enroll) may be canceled

- I. Before submitting the Admission Application Form(or Course Registration Form), applicants must thoroughly understand the admission guidelines. Any disadvantages arising from a lack of understanding are the applicant's responsibility
- J. Personal information provided on the Admission Application Form (or Course Registration Form) and admission documents will be collected and used in accordance with the <sup>r</sup>Consent for Collection, Use, and Provision of Personal Information<sub>J</sub>. The personal information of enrolled students will be used for academic management purposes
- K. Matters related to admission to the Korean Language Education Institute not specified in these guidelines will be determined and implemented by the university's International Education and Exchange Committee. Violation of the above-listed applicant responsibilities may lead to the cancellation of admission or enrollment permission

### 10. Others

### A Promotion(or Completion) and Attendance Requirements

- 1) 10-week Program
  - ▶ Promotion Criteria: Semester attendance rate of 70% or higher and an average score of 65 points or above ※ If the above criteria are not met, according to related regulations, expulsion may be applied
- 2) 5-week Program
  - ▶ Completion Criteria: Semester attendance rate of 70% or higher

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#### 2) Notes

- A) If the refund is given to the international bank account, refund amount could have some difference due to the transfer fee and the currency
- B) The tuition refund process is expected to take approximately 2-3 weeks after the submission of the refund application
- C) In cases where withdrawal, expulsion, or enrollment in a higher-level school occurs, the paid tuition fees will be processed according to the above regulations
