


OUR HUMBLE BEGINNINGS

The Provincial Capitol of Bataan which is one of the provinces in Central Luzon is located in Balanga, hence Balanga is the center of government and financial services in the provinces.




It is surrounded by industrial zones such as the Freeport Area of Bataan, Subic Bay Freeport Zone and Clark Special Economic Zone.



THE BUDDY SYSTEM



As soon as students are sent to our center, they are put under the care and protection of one teacher that serves as their *buddy teacher*.

This buddy teacher stays with them all throughout their stay in the center – attending all their concerns and checking up on them during curfew hours.

This way the center can assure that the *safety* and *satisfaction* of students are well-attended.

EMERGENCY CONTACT LIST & STAY AND LEARN AGREEMENT

In each dormitory rooms, we place an emergency contact list that comes in handy for students in times of need. In this Emergency Contact List, the phone number of the key people (e.g. buddy teacher, security guard, managers and the professor) are there.

Also, students are asked to sign and agree with our 'Stay and Learn Agreement' before anything else which their understand with our rules and regulations and the repercussions once these are not followed.

SECURITY MEASURES & EMERGENCY SITUATIONS



Like any other institutions, our top priority is safety. We make sure that in any activity students do, they are well-taken care of. To help as achieve this, our first line of aid and defense is the buddy teachers as they know and are informed of the whereabouts and shenanigans of the students.

At the same time, our center is highly sheltered by shifting security guard 24 hours a day.






POINT 1







POINT 2


POINT 3







THESE TWO BOOKS ABOVE COME IN 3 LEVELS





BALANGA CITY TOUR


DRAW AND TELL






















GRADUATION DAY

Dubbed as "The Sunniest Place in Bataan," Morong Star Hotel and Resort boasts elegant and modern rooms designed to give an indulgent stay.
























YACHT TOUR




