| Insurance  | Health insurance is required for all international students and scholars in<br>an F or J visa category. Students will be <u>automatically</u> enrolled each<br>semester in the Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) when they register<br>for classes. Embassy or government-sponsored students must provide<br>proof of health insurance coverage in order to be exempted from<br>automatic enrollment. International students may not use insurance from<br>their home country. Cost is approximately \$500 per semester, subject to<br>change.               |

| Extra Fees | Some courses have "Electronic Course Material" that is required for the<br>course and costs between <b>\$30-100</b> . Other courses will have course fees<br>between <b>\$5-100</b> . Students will need to purchase their own textbooks,<br>either through the Campus Bookstore, Amazon, Chegg,<br>CampusBookRentals, or other sites.<br>Students will be responsible for paying the <b>\$65</b> International Admissions<br>Application Fee, <b>shipping fees</b> for DS2019 documents, and the <b>\$60</b> Foreign<br>Student Fee. | Tuition    | Students will pay tuition at their home institution. A charge for tuition will<br>show on the student's bill at Weber State, but will be <b>WAIVED 2 weeks</b><br><b>AFTER the start of the semester.</b> Please be assured, students will only<br>need to pay for the extra fees above, insurance, housing, and cost of living.<br>Students are <u>NOT</u> eligible for scholarships at Weber State, unless explicitly<br>told by Myranda that they are eligible.  |
