





Evaluation 	<p>Lesson Focus: Dribbling Skills</p>  <p>Students will learn that dribbling is one of the first and most important skills in soccer. It's crucial to be able to move with the ball and change direction at any time. There are a number of different qualities that can make a soccer player a great dribbler. Students will learn to recognize when and where to dribble.</p> <p>Activities include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Stretching 2. Games/Activities that practice dribbling skills 3. Evaluation 	<p>Lesson Focus: Shooting Skills</p>  <p>The most exciting play in soccer is when a goal is scored. If you play as a forward or in an offensive midfielder position, you will want to learn how to shoot the soccer ball. Students will learn how to improve their soccer shooting skills.</p> <p>Activities include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Stretching 2. Games/Activities that practice shooting skills 3. Evaluation 	<p>Lesson Focus: Defending and Attacking</p>  <p>A good solid defense is a key to winning games in soccer. Goals may be more exciting, but defense can win games. You may think at first that defense is only the job of the goalkeeper, but you couldn't be further from the truth.
